TEIGNMOUTH HARBOUR COMMISSION – LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS 02/14

TEIGNMOUTH PIER

As a result of the recent storm force weather conditions Teignmouth Pier has suffered significant damage. The Pier has been shut off to personnel and the electrical power supply has been isolated. This has resulted in the 2 Fixed Green navigation lights vertically displaced on the end of the pier to be extinguished until further notice.

As a temporary measure, a green navigation buoy with a light flashing green every 3 seconds at night has been laid off the end of the pier to mark the Pier's extremity.

Mariners should avoid making passage between the buoy and the shore.

Effective Date: This Notice to Mariners will be effective until further notice.
