## **TEIGNMOUTH HARBOUR COMMISSION – LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS 01/18**

### **WATERCRAFT REGISTRATION 2018**

It is requested that all operators of power driven water craft who wish to navigate on the waters of Teignmouth Harbour and the Teign Estuary within the area managed by Teignmouth Harbour Commission (THC) (The Ness to the entrance to Stover Canal at Newton Abbot) register their craft with THC using the Water Craft Registration Form and pay particular attention to the Water Craft Operators Code of Conduct and the need for insurance.

There is an administration charge payable of £10 for the calendar year (01.01.18 – 31.12.18).

All Water Craft operators in possession of a Mooring Licence Permit, or with proof visible on the boat, of registration with a Teignmouth, Shaldon or Teign Estuary, BOAT, Rowing, Sailing or Water Ski Club are considered to be registered with the THC and do not need to take any action.

Operators of non power driven water craft are encouraged to register at their discretion.

Registration Forms and permits last from January to December and are available primarily from the THC website (payment can be made by telephone, if you are registered you can also pay on-line) the THC Harbour Office (Quay Road) and additionally from: Teignbridge District Council Car Park Office (Polly Steps); Teign Dive Centre (Gales Hill); Sea Sports SW (New Quay/Back Beach) who are also authorised to collect charges on behalf of THC.

THC Harbour Patrols will ask for proof of registration where necessary.

Effective Date: This Notice to Mariners will be effective until 31 December 2018 when it will be reviewed and renewed.
