

Teignmouth Harbour Users Information



Water—Skiing

Water-Skiing is **Prohibited** in the estuary except in the designated area near Coombe Cellars for members of South Devon Waterski Club. Tel: 01395 277060 / 07768 302522 / 01626 873744 / 07974 506644 for membership enquiries.



Windsurfing

Prohibited between Shaldon Bridge and The Ness Shaldon. **Permitted** above Shaldon Bridge.



Personal Watercraft / Jet Skis (PWC's)

All PWC's are prohibited in the Estuary above Shaldon Bridge. PWC's are permitted below Shaldon Bridge to make passage to and from the sea between sunrise and sunset with a current permit. PWC's must follow the Teignmouth Harbour PWC' Operators Code of Conduct.

Personal Watercraft Code of Conduct

Operators must be 16 or older to use PWC's in the harbour.

PWC users will adhere to Collision Regulations at all times.

PWC's will operate without making excess wash or noise.

PWC's will abide by all Harbour Directions and Teignbridge Bylaws.

Personal Water Craft Registration Scheme

All PWC's must carry a current valid permit before use in the Harbour.

Permits may be obtained by registering with Teignmouth Harbour Commission. Registration and Permits are available from various locations including, Teignmouth Harbour Master, Polly Steps car park and Teign diving Centre. Registration is for a calendar year and costs £5.

All Craft—Speed Limits

Estuary—6 Knots for the whole estuary between the Ness at Shaldon and Stover Canal near Newton Abbot.

Open Coast— *All Powered Leisure Craft* are prohibited between the shore and the yellow marker buoys parallel to the shore. Access to shore permitted via buoyed watercraft access lanes.
