None having been undertaken by Mannin for last 3 years Pilots presently working to +0.6m Dredging in progress with intention to get to +1.2m by end first scheduled works and to +1.5m by completion October's dredging schedule
Mooring availability		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Maintained moorings – Non presently available. Non-maintained – available to allocate within two to four (location/depth vessel dependent)
Environmental Issues		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Abandonment of water-craft is resulting in a non-recoverable cost burden to the Commission Beach erosion in way of Lifeboat launch access and egress to river. County/Local Authorities, together with EA to be consulted

Harbour Patrols	Green	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Two Part time harbour assistants taken on to assist harbour operations Six volunteer staff taken on for weekend duties initially Our salaried and volunteer staff are paramount for Safety on the River.
Mooring Fees	Orange	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We anticipate that with rising costs in 2023, that there may well be an uplift for 2024. Mooring holders will be advised in September of any potential rise in the fees
PNPF	Orange	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At the end of 2022 we owed the fund £430,716. THC are presently in negotiation with the fund to ensure most efficient payback and minimise interest charges. Our present total contribution represents 0.47%
Harbour Revision Order	Green	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Solicitors proceeding with drafting of Order and document will be available for public review at the time of the consultation period. The Commission wish to put a working group together, to ensure we achieve maximum benefit, including members of the consultative group.
THC Strategy Policy	Green	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Commissioners is actively pursuing the develop a forward-looking strategy for the Teign involving all stake holders.
