The 64th Shaldon Water Carnival takes place this year on Saturday 2nd August and one of its highlights is the unique Decorated Boat Parade. This nautical fancy dress parade is the only one of its kind in the country and is great fun - a spectacle in which lots of brilliant boats are dressed up and assembled just off Shaldon Beach to entertain the crowds on the beach, impress the judges and win substantial cash prizes. As usual, there are 3 categories of boats : 1) Boats under Motor; 2) Paddleboards, Canoes and Kayaks; 3) Seine Boats and Dinghies, and first place in each category will win a cash prize of £100, with £75 and £50 respectively for 2nd and 3rd place. The Water Carnival would welcome even more boat entrants to the Parade, and registration is easy - just go to the Committee tent on Shaldon Beach before the boast assemble on Carnival Day (so before 4.30pm) and register your boat in the Parade for free.
